Geek Fest is a free, all-ages welcome celebration of geek culture in all of its forms! It includes comics and art, table top games, technology, cosplay, and much, much more!

This year's event took place on Saturday, October 14 at the Kalamazoo Expo Center and was hosted by the Kalamazoo Public Library, Paw Paw District Library, Portage District Library, Richland Community Library and Vicksburg District Library. The Paw Paw District Library's role in this event was in part supported by Friends funds, and as you can see from the photos at left and below, the event was enjoyed by young and old.

Guests included award-winning young adult author Mark Oshiro, most recently known for coauthoring with Rick Riordan on *The Sun and the Star*. Organizers also welcomed DMScotty, who runs a hugely popular YouTube channel (*The DMs Craft*) where he demonstrates how to make props and set pieces for Dungeons & Dragons (DnD) and other table top games. Crowd favorites of Sew Excited Cosplay, Kenji, Paul Sizer, and all of the usual Gaming Masters were back for the fun!
